What is referencing?

Referencing is a standardized system used in the academic communities to acknowledge the sources of information and ideas, theories, quotes, facts and any other evidence and information used to support their research or assignments.

Why referencing is important?

- to Avoid Plagiarism by making it clear which ideas are your own and which are someone else's
- gives Supporting Evidence for the Ideas, Arguments, Analysis and Opinions
- Showing the readers the Sources of Information
- allows readers to Identify, Follow-up, and Verify the Sources that author has used

Citation and Reference

 A list of sources author have cited in the text arranged in the order within the article is called citations or in-text citations.

• The references at the end of the article is called the reference list.
